BTI is seeking 2 – 3 innovative scientists who together will launch an interdisciplinary program in an area that is new to the institute and is open to any area of plant science, or any field with the potential to contribute to BTI's mission. The interview process will include a public symposium on November 5th for applicants to present their current research and future vision. Interviewees will then have an opportunity on November 6th to interact and discuss potential collaborative projects, which will be submitted in the form of short synopses in the weeks after the symposium. Clusters with the greatest promise for successfully founding a new interdisciplinary program will be invited for a formal interview in early 2019.
